Directions to the Naughton Chalet:

From the East: From Hwy 17 West (Southwest Bypass), take the Municipal Rd 55 West exit . Stay on MR 55 passing the Lively turn-off (MR24) at the lights. Continue 4 km to Naughton. A small blue cross country ski sign “Naughton Trails” is located on the right (across from Penguin Research). Turn right onto St Louis St .Turn left onto Denis Ave. The Chalet is at the end of Denis Ave.

From Sudbury: Follow Lorne St West until it turns into Municipal Rd 55. Continue on MR 55 past the Lively turn-off (MR24) at the lights. Continue 4 km to Naughton. A small blue cross country ski sign “Naughton Trails” is located on the right (across from Penguin Research). Turn right onto St Louis St. Turn left onto Denis Ave. The Chalet is at the end of Denis Ave.

From the West: Highway 17 East to Municipal Rd 55 East. Proceed to Naughton. A small blue cross country ski sign “Naughton Trails” is on the left (across from Penguin Research). Turn left onto St Louis St. Turn left onto Denis Ave. The Chalet is at the end of Denis Ave.

Beaver Lake Trails: 45 Club Road, Worthington, ON

From Sudbury: Take the Trans Canada Hwy 17 West toward Sault Ste. Marie. From the Hwy 17 – MR 55 interchange, travel 32 km west. Turn left on Ella Rd and immediately right onto Club Rd. Continue up the hill and the parking lot for the Beaver Lake Sports and Cultural Club will appear on the left. The Trailhead is at the back (west end) of the parking lot.

From Espanola: Take the Trans Canada Hwy 17 East toward Sudbury. Turn right on Lorne Falls Rd and immediately left onto Club Rd. Continue up the hill and the parking lot for the Beaver Lake Sports and Cultural Club will appear on the right. The Trailhead is at the back (west end) of the parking lot.

From Chlemsford: Take Municipal Road 35 South to Azilda. After you pass the town of Azilda, turn left onto Montée Rouleau (MR 18) and continue straight through to Gagnon St. which ends at the club parking area. The Trailhead is on the left side of the road.
